Clinical Site Letter of Agreement

Name of Organization agrees to participate as a clinical training site for the Idaho SEARCH program.

As an Idaho SEARCH participating site, we agree to provide a clinical contact person to identify and coordinate a preceptor to supervise the participant's rotation, student-housing opportunities, and to also identify a community mentor to be involved with the participant's overall community experience during the rotation. The Idaho SEARCH student will also complete a Community Project during the rotation.

IPCA will reimburse \$500 toward the expenses of staff time for the Idaho SEARCH rotation for each participant placed at the site September 30, 2009 to September 29, 2010.

In addition, the Idaho SEARCH student will be paid \$500 for housing and travel expenses to and from the clinical preceptor site, \$30 to help offset costs associated with their Community Experience projects and \$40 per day for up to 25 days during the rotation. A Community Experience Checklist can be used to assist with planning broader student community experiences during the rotation.

Each participating Idaho SEARCH rotation site will complete a Site Application and Capacity Survey to identify opportunities for student experiences and training.

During the rotation, the Idaho SEARCH Program Director or Specialist will contact the participant and preceptor individually to discuss opportunities for the program improvement and to learn more about the community project.
